Advancing innovative care models
during a year of shifting health coverage

2019 Annual Report

During 2019, Every Child Pediatrics provided comprehensive, high-quality health care and support services to nearly 24,000 children and advanced innovative care models, which prepared us for the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic.

We piloted telehealth programs and upgraded our communication systems to enable secure communication with patients by video and text. We also saw positive and concerning trends with our patients. A robust economy and low unemployment rates led to more children having commercial health insurance and Child Health Plan Plus coverage.

However, harmful federal immigration policies created fear in the immigrant community and

contributed to a sizeable drop in the number of patients with Health First Colorado (Medicaid) coverage and a 16% increase in the number of

patients who became uninsured. Children who lack health insurance seek care less frequently and face higher health risks, underscoring the need for our trusted and affordable services.

Every Child Pediatrics saw an overall two percent increase in patients served, but visit totals were dampened due to reductions in provider capacity and lower visits by uninsured patients.

Lori Cohn, Director of Integrated Services, won a Health Equity Award from the Center for Health Progress

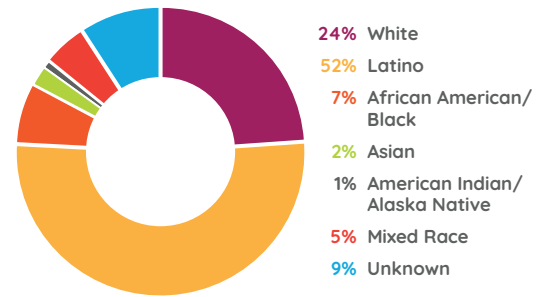
In 2019, we provided care to close to

at more than 75,000 medical visits and provided over \$1 million in uncompensated care to 2,500 uninsured patients.

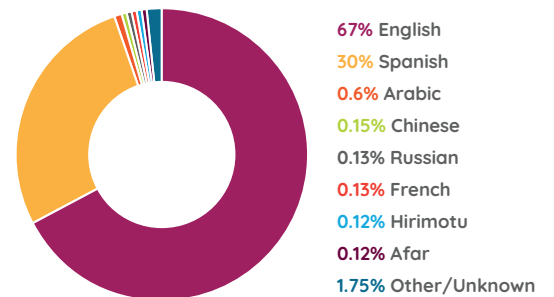
Who We Serve

Ethnic/Racial Background



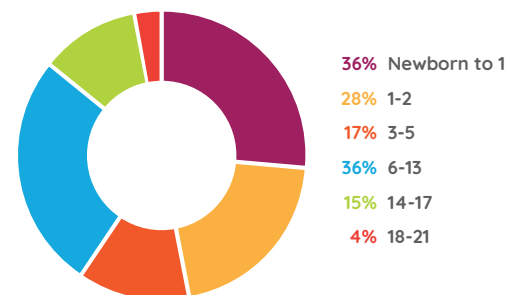
Note: Many Latino patients also identify as White but we separated them here because we are combining ethnicity and race

Languages

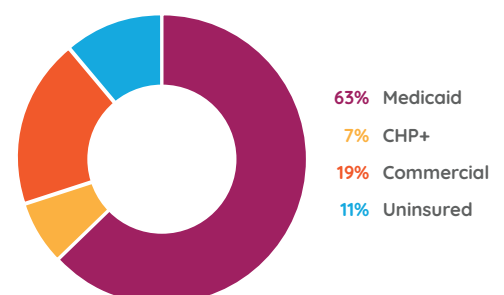


Note: There are 30+ languages spoken by patients
