The COVID-19 pandemic revealed glaring health disparities in our communities. Health disparities are preventable differences in health outcomes due to racial, ethnic, ability, immigration status, or other marginalizing characteristics.

2020 was a challenging and transformative year for us at Every Child Pediatrics.

Like many healthcare organizations, we quickly pivoted our operations in the spring in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, postponing non-urgent appointments and implementing a virtual check-in and telemedicine program.

We were fortunate to keep all of our locations open throughout the year and continued to meet

In the midst of the early months of the pandemic, we also experienced a leadership transition, as former Executive Director Jessica Dunbar left Every Child Pediatrics, and Dr. Laura Luzietti moved into the position.

2020 Highlights

We advanced the implementation of HealthySteps across all our sites. An evidence-based, early childhood integrated behavioral health model that promotes caregiver and child resilience, the health, well-being of babies and toddlers and school readiness in the context of pediatric primary care.



Our patients, as young as one year old, now receive visual acuity screening with the new GoCheck Kids mobile device.



Photoscreening is a Cloud-Based Vision Screening aimed to protect children from preventable vision impairment and blindness.



We rapidly replaced many in-person visits with telemedicine visits enabling critical appointments to continue during COVID-19 and ensuring children across Colorado could still get the care they needed virtually while staying at home.



We received the prestigious BabyFriendly®



designation from the World Health Organization (WHO), positioning us as a global leader in providing evidence-based practices to protect, promote and support breastfeeding.

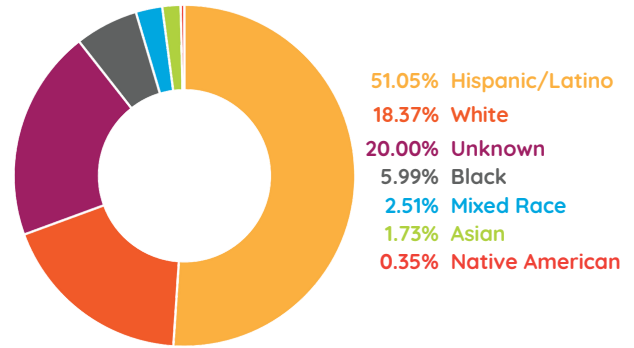
In 2020, we provided care to over

Ethnic/Racial Background

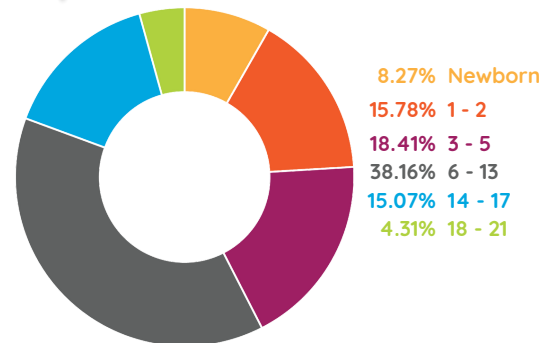


Languages

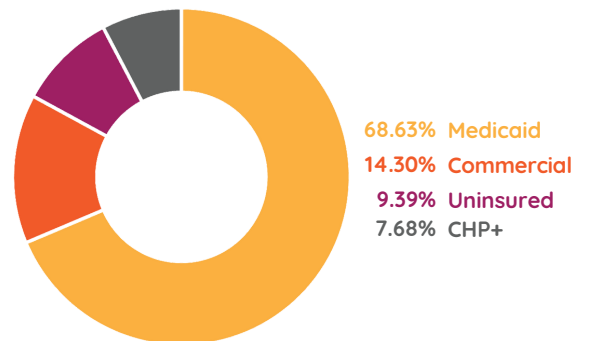


Note: Although English and Spanish are the main languages spoken by patients (69% & 29% respectively), we have many other patients coming from different cultures and traditions.
