SPECIAL PROGRAMS

REACH OUT AND READ

RMYC partners with Reach Out and Read, a literacy program that helps children prepare for success in school by providing books and having providers talk about the importance of reading at every Well Child visit.



TEEN HEALTH PROGRAM

We address the medical, social, emotional, and personal needs of the teen and allow teens to have private time with their provider.



ADOLESCENT TREATMENT

Our providers assess teens for risky behaviors and our staff provide services in other youth facilities across Colorado.



THRIVE CLINIC

A specialized team of health professionals provide nutritional advice, additional medical attention and free food to kids who need support to grow at a healthy rate.



HOLIDAY ASSISTANCE

We provide holiday assistance and a special holiday event for families at the end of the year.

INTEGRATED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

We provide a range of integrated behavioral health services including early intervention, consultation, and education for youth and their caretakers during each visit.



ASTHMA CLINIC

We offer treatment options and education on the proper use of medicines, nebulizers, and inhalers.

SMOKING CESSATION

Patients or parents who smoke are directed to Quitline referral forms and other educational tools to help them quit.

POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION We assess for the presence and

degree of possible depression, provide resources, and refer mothers to mental health centers. support groups, and counseling.

GET FIT CLINIC

Our clinic provides care and education to kids with a high Body Mass Index. The focus is on healthy living through proper eating and exercise habits.
