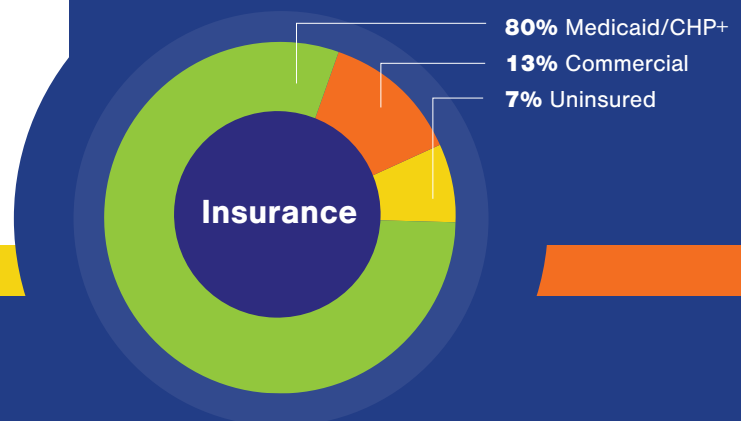
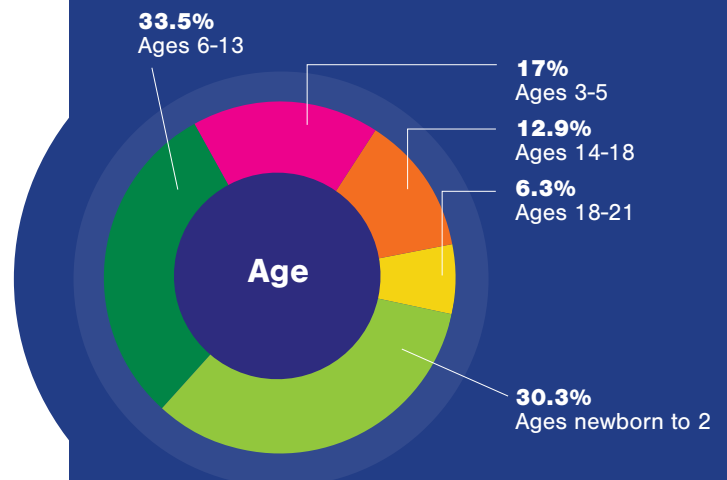
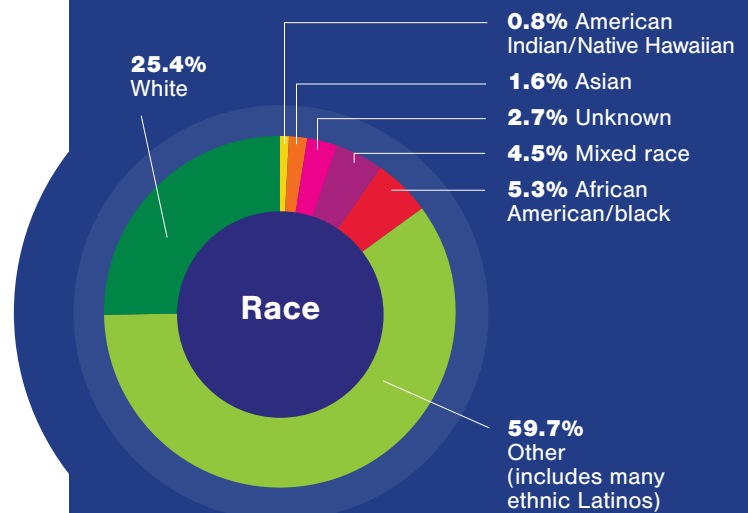

Rocky Mountain Youth Clinics (RMYC) was established as a non-profit organization in 1996 and is now one of the largest pediatric health practices in Colorado, serving more than 23,000 infants and youth at three medical offices and nine school-based health centers in Metro Denver, Fort Collins, the west slope and southwest Colorado.

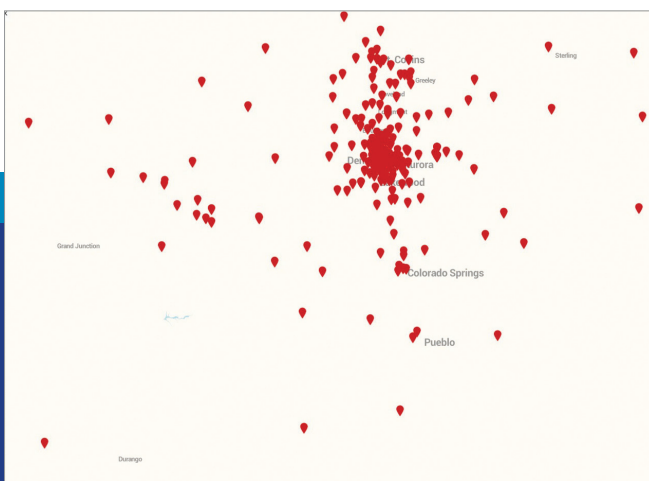
Our experienced professionals focus on meeting all of the child's health needs with medical and dental care, behavioral health counseling, nutrition, literacy, healthy lifestyle programs and connections to support services such as housing and transportation. More than 85% of our patients live in low-income households.

- ★ Celebrated the organization's 20th anniversary, our most successful year to date, serving the highest number of infants and youth across all sites.
- ★ Implemented a new team-based care model to strengthen relationships with patients and improve care coordination within RMYC's medical, dental, nutrition, behavioral health and social services programs and with outside providers.
- ★ Launched a new patient portal and converted to a new electronic medical records system, allowing RMYC to improve data collection, tracking and care coordination.
- ★ Centralized and streamlined scheduling and billing operations to improve customer service.

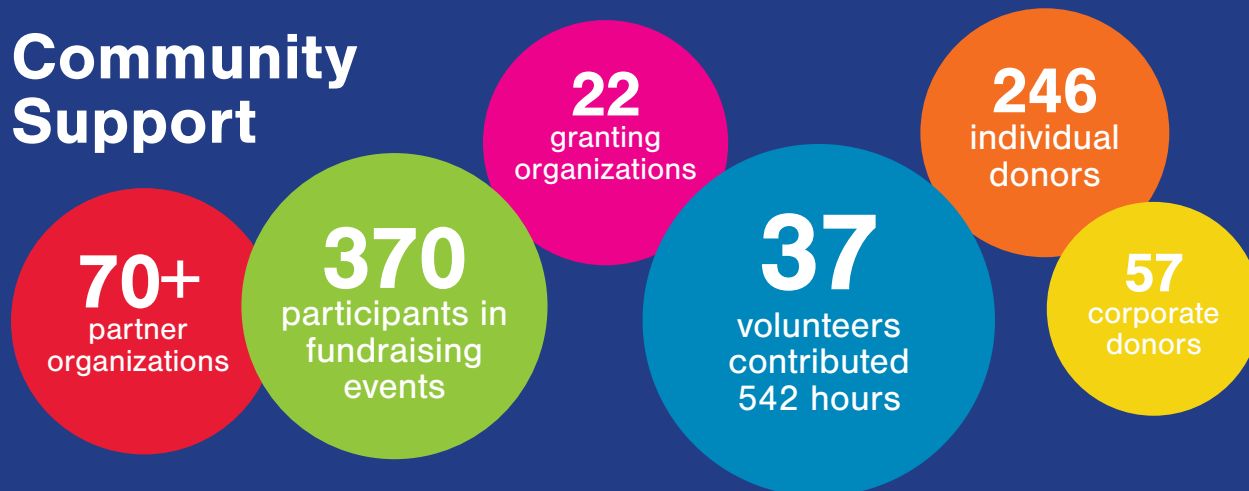
