OUR REACH & IMPACT

Our Mission - Every child, regardless of their ability to pay

We provide primary medical care and integrated services to every child, regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay. We seek out children living in the most vulnerable situations and build support around them, so they have a Medical Home. Every Child Pediatrics has been a critical part of the Colorado community since 1996, providing medical care, behavioral and mental health services, and other basic social supports to over 57,000 children under our care. We never turn a child away.


Important Aspects of Our Mission

Care Navigation Services: Our in-house care navigators serve as case workers and referral specialists to ensure all families have vital resources to help their children thrive. Care Navigators arrange transportation to specialty clinics, ensure referrals to specialty hospitals are expedited, and work with the Colorado medical community to help children without insurance access specialty care, even when some providers may limit their Medicaid and uninsured patients.

Integrated Behavioral and Mental Health **Services:** We've seen a significant growth in depression screenings and referrals to behavioral health providers (BHP), and this has caused us to scale up our in-house services. Each clinic has a BHP, and we partner with several third-party agencies to for our patients.

School-based Health Centers: School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs) are essential to Colorado's healthcare safety net. They are located inside or on school grounds and are staffed by providers from various disciplines. The health centers are designed to serve students with limited access to care, often because they are low-income, uninsured, or live in isolated areas - 95% of the patients accessing ECP's SBHCs come from low-income families.

Special Needs Population: Our model of care is to provide the time and additional attention to every child, as our patient population comes to us with complex needs beyond typical medical routines. We specialize in patients with greater needs, and we have several providers specially trained to care for children with special needs, such as autism, Down Syndrome, and other neurodevelopmental disorders. Our goal is to meet all needs and help children thrive in all aspects of life.
