2024 Highlights

In 2024, Every Child Pediatrics continued building strong momentum toward expanding access to care, deepening community partnerships, and strengthening the systems that support children and families across the Denver metro area. This year marked meaningful progress in both program expansion and infrastructure development to support long-term impact.

Expanded Access to Care: Continued growth of services for children at our Samaritan House clinic in partnership with Catholic Charities, increasing our ability to serve highly vulnerable populations experiencing housing instability and barriers to care.

Community Investment & Development Growth: Scaled our development and community engagement programming, highlighted by the launch of our inaugural charity 5K + Family Fun Run in partnership with presenting sponsor Suncor Energy in Commerce City, bringing together families, staff, and partners in support of underserved children.

Care Model Innovation: Advanced our team-based care model project to improve coordination across clinical, behavioral health, and support services, strengthening continuity and quality of care for patients and families.

Public Health & Vaccine Confidence: Expanded vaccine anxiety resources and continued grant-funded work focused on addressing vaccine hesitancy, helping ensure families have the education and support needed to make informed health decisions.

Growing Need & Reach: Continued to see a steady increase in the number of uninsured children served, reinforcing both the urgency of our mission and the importance of sustainable funding and access strategies.

OUR MISSION

Every Child Pediatrics provides comprehensive health care to every child, regardless of their circumstance, insurance status or ability to pay.

We provide a Medical Home for children with complex life situations, and offer services to support their entire health and well being. We see a high number of uninsured children, as well as children enrolled in Medicaid.

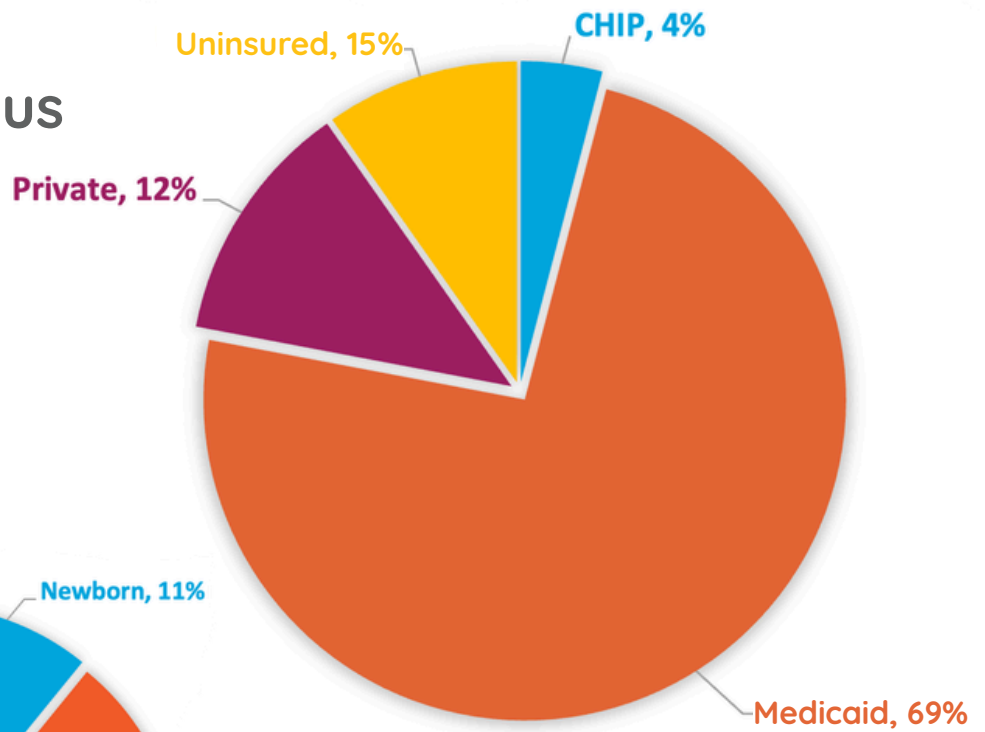
Every Child Pediatrics is experiencing a significant and sustained uptick in the number of uninsured children, driven largely by the Medicaid unwinding and resulting disruptions in coverage that have created major barriers for families trying to maintain access to insurance and care. This shift is rapidly reshaping the landscape of pediatric health in Colorado, with projections indicating that our clinics are trending toward serving double—or more—the number of uninsured children in 2025 compared to prior years.



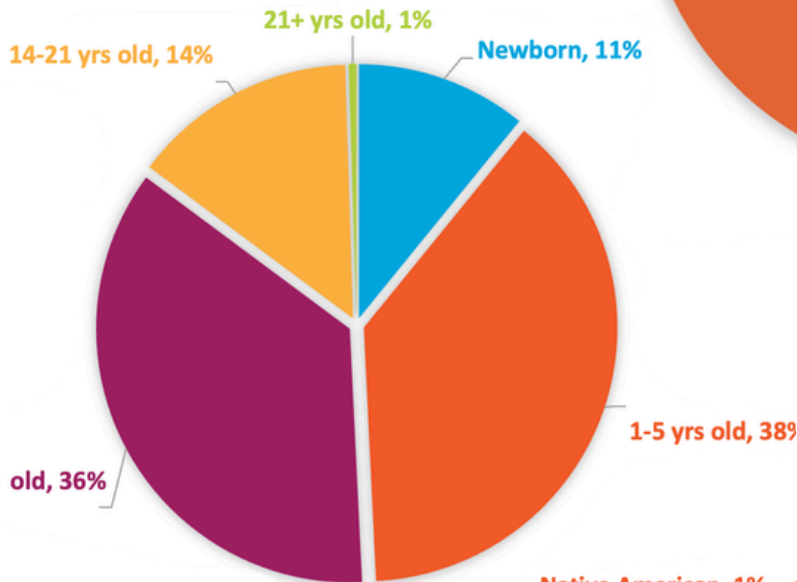
In response, Every Child Pediatrics is not only expanding access to care but also actively elevating these issues at the state and national level. Our team has been engaged in advocacy efforts at the NBC Nightly News and at the Colorado State Capitol, working to bring visibility to the real-world impact of coverage loss on children and families and to advance policy solutions that protect access to care.

Patient Background

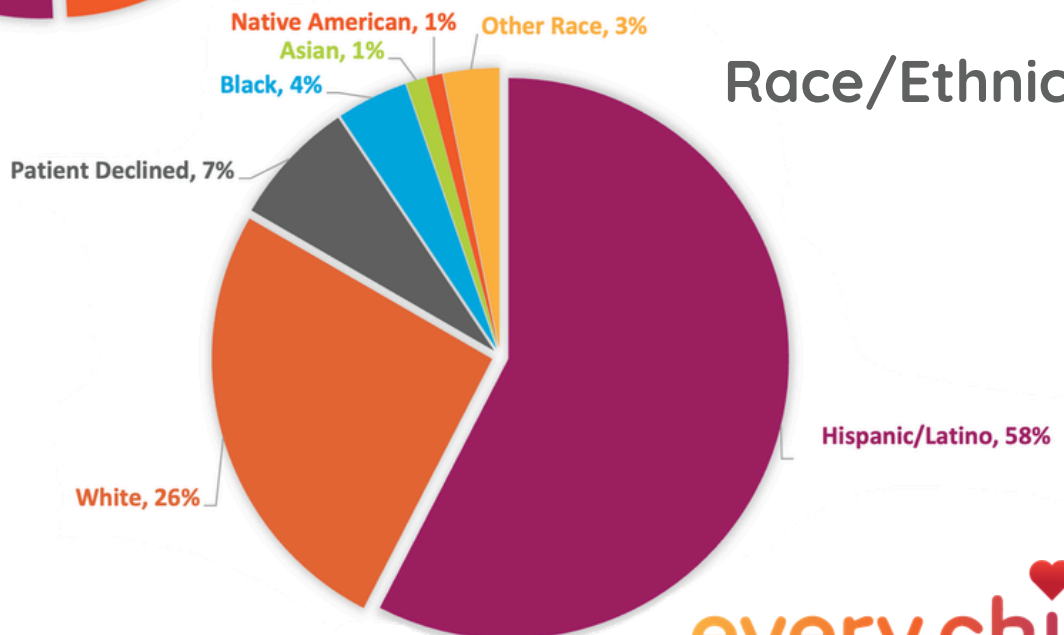
Insurance Status
